Hyung Training Worksheets

Attached are 3 examples for scoring Hyung/Weapon competition that contain some problems the scorekeeper will need to know how to resolve.

Please take the time to understand how to calculate scores and helpful tips such as: General

- Try our best to pronounce the competitor's name. Call the competitors up in a loud clear voice. Many competitors have the same first name so be sure to call them up by their **full name** and studio if necessary. You want to be sure the right competitor is up.
- Always announce who is up and who is on-deck.
- If you make a mistake, let the center judge know AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

Hyung

- Use pencil to record the scores and write LEGIBLY! Lightly cross out the high and low scores and record the sum of the remaining scores. They do NOT calculate the average score.
- Calculate the scores as soon as the competitor is done.

1. Were there any ties?

Yes – four people (Amanda, Nicole, Jennifer and Susan) were tied for 1st

2. If there were, how were they resolved?

The high and low scores that were dropped were added back in. After these scores were added back in there was still a tie for 2^{nd} . Nicole and Jennifer have to repeat their original hyung and be rescored to determine the winner.

3. Who placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd and co-3rd?

First – Amanda Second – Nicole or Jennifer Third – Nicole or Jennifer Co-third - Susan
